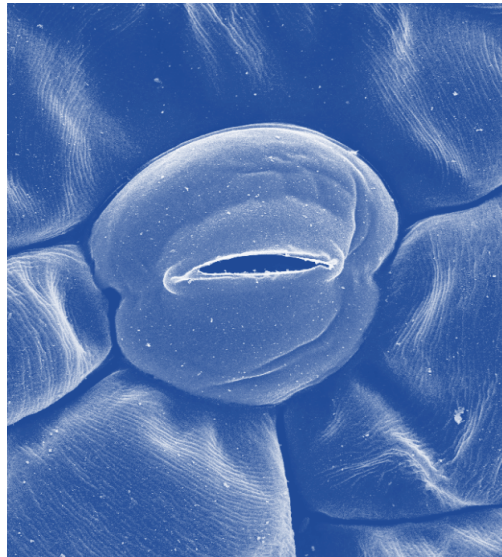
CYBO stands for
